

Introduction


We are looking to attract partners that share in our vision of equitable access to clean water, healthy habitats for all, with the engagement of diverse communities.



About Us

Tinker's Creek Watershed Partners (TCWP) is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) watershed organization officially established in 2006. Our mission is to protect and restore water quality and habitats of the Tinker's Creek and Brandywine Creek watersheds through community partnerships. The Tinker's Creek watershed drains 96.4 square miles and is the largest tributary to the Cuyahoga River. The watershed area spans 24 communities in Cuyahoga, Summit, Portage and Geauga counties.

TCWP is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors who bring a variety of expertise in the fields of stormwater management, environmental education, engineering, natural resources conservation, planning, law, and economic development. TCWP is guided in their efforts by a 5-year strategic plan. TCWP endeavors to protect and restore the watershed and educate the public by four Ohio and U.S. EPA endorsed nonpoint source implementation strategic plans (NPS-IS Plans). Each plan encompasses a subset of the Tinker's Creek and Brandywine Creek watersheds.

About The Event



The event will take place at Farmer's Feast in Bottlehouse Brewery & Meadery in Cleveland Heights. Anticipated event numbers are 50-75 people with a menu designed by Chef Rasul Welch, who specializes in farm-to-table and field-to-table creations.

The menu will include a selection of locally foraged and invasive species ingredients. TCWP, along with expert local foragers, plan to lead volunteers on 1-2 foraging harvest hikes in April to gather wild and invasive plant edibles. These items will be used as Chef Welch creates a special menu for the event.

Event speakers and educational materials will feature the benefits of eating sustainably, foraging locally, and closing the loop on food waste.
